# ZI 9AT TRANSMISSION COVER SHIELD INSTALLATION MANUAL

Study these instructions completely before proceeding to assembly. The installer must have a thorough knowledge of automotive systems operation. If unfamiliar with any of the concepts outlined in this instruction, we recommend the installation be completed by a qualified professional.

### TOOLS REQUIRED:

- Hydraulic Jack
- (2) 2-Ton (or greater) Jack Stands
- Ratchet
- Ratchet Extension(s)
- Assorted Metric Sockets
- Assorted Metric Wrenches
- Torque Wrench
- E10 Socket

### **SAFETY REQUIREMENTS:**

- Always wear safety glasses and any necessary protective garments. If using any fluids, chemicals, or solvents, a respirator is recommended.
- Always use properly rated jack stands when working under your vehicle.
- Always keep limbs and parts away from moving drivetrain parts.
- Always turn the ignition to the OFF position and disconnect the NEGATIVE battery terminal.
- Only operate drivetrain in safe space and well-ventilated areas.

#### **BEFORE YOU BEGIN:**

Remove contents from the Z1 Off-Road 9AT Transmission Cover Shield and verify that ALL necessary hardware is present.

### **PROCEDURE:**

- 1. Place the transmission in Park position (or in Reverse gear if equipped with a manual transmission). Apply the parking brake.
- 2. Locate proper jacking points on vehicle's chassis (refer to vehicle's Owner Manual). Raise and support vehicle using jack & jack stands.
- 3. Locate the Transmission Pan. Remove the (6) six bolts securing the Transmission Pan circled in *Figure 1* below, retain this hardware. The Transmission Pan bolts need an E10 Socket for removal, however an 8mm will work if absolutely necessary.



- 4. Locate the Z1 Transmission Cover Shield. Remove the (5) five rubber grommets and the (1) one M6 bolt securing the Service Panel to the Transmission Cover Shield.
- 5. Position the Z1 Transmission Cover Shield over the Transmission Pan. Using the (6) six Transmission Pan bolts removed in *Step 3*, secure the Transmission Cover Shield to the Transmission Pan. Torque to <u>70 in-</u><u>lbs</u>. *Figure 2*.

**<u>NOTE</u>**: The Figure below shows the Transmission on a Nissan Z, the process is still the same for other vehicles.

6. Locate the Transmission Service Panel and the (1) one M6 bolt removed in *Step 4*. Reinstall them onto the Z1 Transmission Cover Shield. *Figure 3*.



7. Reinstall the (5) five Rubber Grommets removed in Step 4.

**<u>NOTE</u>**: The (3) three M6 Washers will not be used, these Washers are for the Nissan Z, as this Transmission Cover Shield works for that as well.

- 8. Safely lower vehicle from jack stands.
- 9. Take your car for a test drive.
