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## ZI DOOR STOPPER REBUILD KIT INSTALLATION MANUAL



#### PROLOGUE:

Study these instructions completely before proceeding to assembly. The installer must have a thorough knowledge of automotive systems operation. If unfamiliar with any of the concepts outlined in this instruction, we recommend the installation be completed by a qualified professional.

#### WARNING!

Extreme caution should be taken when performing maintenance or performance upgrades to your vehicle. Please observe and abide by any Warning or Caution labels placed on the various components and tools used when servicing your vehicle. If you have any questions regarding installation or the various components included with the Z1 Motorsports Door Stopper Rebuild Kit, consult with a Professional Mechanic, or contact Z1 Motorsports for more information.

#### **SAFETY REQUIREMENTS:**

#### **BEFORE YOU BEGIN:**

Remove contents from the Z1 Motorsports Door Stopper Rebuild Kit and verify that ALL necessary hardware is present.

Refer to the Table of Contents on the next page for your applicable vehicle to remove the Door Panel or for Check Link Disassembly.

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## <u>350Z</u>

- 1. Place the transmission in Park position (or in Reverse gear if equipped with a manual transmission). Apply the parking brake.
- 2. Open the Driver Side Door.
- 3. Pull the Door Release Handle and remove the small Trim Piece behind it with a Trim Removal Tool. *Figure 1*.

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6. Locate (2) two Plastic Guides and (2) two Rubber Bushings. Assemble them as shown below. The nubs in the Rubber Bushings will line up with the holes in the Plastic Guides. The orientation they are shown in is also how they will need to be installed into the Silver Plate. *Figure 107*.



- 7. Using some Silicone Spray or another equivalent lubricant, lubricate the Rubber Bushings and the inside of the Silver Plate.
- 8. Orient the Rubber Bushings and Plastic Guides around the Check Link. We found it easiest to position the Rubber Bushings slightly inside of the Silver Plate and push the Plastic Guides into the plate. This is a difficult step and may take a few tries. Ensure the orientation of the Bushings/Guides is the same as below. *Figure 108*.

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9. With the Bushings and Guides in, reinstall the Plate and bend the tabs back to secure the Door Stoppers before reinstalling into the vehicle.

## TAB CHECK LINK

1. With the Check Link removed, use pliers to bend and open up the (4) four metal tabs that secure the (2) two Check Link Plates together. *Figure 109*.

3. Locate (2) two Plastic Guides and (2) two Rubber Bushings. Assemble them as shown below. The nubs in the Rubber Bushings will line up with the holes in the Plastic Guides. The orientation they are shown in is how they will need to be installed into the Silver Plate. *Figure 111*.



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- 4. Use Silicone Spray or another equivalent lubricant and lubricate the Rubber Bushings and the inside of the Silver Plate.
- 5. Orient the Rubber Bushings and Plastic Guides around the Check Link. We found it easiest to position the Rubber Bushings slightly inside of the Silver Plate and push the Plastic Guides into the plate. This is a difficult step and may take a few tries. Ensure the orientation of the Bushings/Guides is the same as below. *Figure 112*.

6. Follow *Step 1* in reverse order to reinstall the top plate and bend the tabs back to secure the Door Stoppers before reinstalling into the vehicle.
