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# Z1 Q50/Q60 TOURING EXHAUST INSTALLATION MANUAL

#### PROLOGUE:

Study these instructions completely before proceeding to assembly. The installer must have a thorough knowledge of automotive systems operation. If unfamiliar with any of the concepts outlined in this instruction, we recommend the installation be completed by a qualified professional.

#### WARNING!

Extreme caution should be taken when performing maintenance or performance upgrades to your vehicle. Please observe and abide by any Warning or Caution labels placed on the various components and tools used when servicing your vehicle. If you have any questions regarding installation or the various components included with the Z1 Motorsports Q50/Q60 Touring Exhaust, consult with a Professional Mechanic, or contact Z1 Motorsports for more information.

## **TOOLS REQUIRED:**

- Hydraulic Jack
- (2) 2-Ton (or greater) Jack Stands
- Ratchet
- Ratchet Extension(s)
- Assorted Metric Wrenches

### **SAFETY REQUIREMENTS:**

- Assorted Metric Sockets
- Torque Wrench
- Channel Lock Pliers
- Rust Penetrant
- Always wear safety glasses and any necessary protective garments. If using any fluids, chemicals, or solvents, a respirator is recommended.
- Always turn the ignition to the OFF position and disconnect the NEGATIVE battery terminal.
- Always use properly rated jack stands when working under your vehicle.
- Always keep limbs and parts away from moving drivetrain parts.
- Only operate drivetrain in safe space and well-ventilated areas.

### **BEFORE YOU BEGIN:**

Remove contents from the Z1 Motorsports Q50/Q60 Touring Exhaust and verify that ALL necessary hardware is present.

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# PROCEDURE:

- 1. Place the transmission in Park position (or in Reverse gear if equipped with a manual transmission). Apply the parking brake.
- 2. Locate the proper jacking points on the vehicle's chassis (refer to the Vehicle's Owner's Manual). Raise and support the vehicle using a jack and jack stands.
- 3. Remove the OE Catback Exhaust System. If you are replacing the Y-Pipe, do this at this point as well. Use a Rust Penetrant on all exhaust hardware to help easily remove hardware. *Figure 1*.

**<u>NOTE</u>**: Refer to the <u>Standard Y-Pipe</u> or <u>Premium Y-Pipe</u> Installation Guides for Y-Pipe removal and installation.



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4. Remove the (2) two OE Exhaust Hangers that support the OE Muffler. Each is held on by (3) three bolts, retain this hardware. *Figure 2*.




 Locate the Driver and Passenger Side Hangers. Position them into the vehicle where the OE Hangers were removed in *Step 4*. The folded part of the Bracket should point up, and the Rubber Hanger Stud should point towards the front of the vehicle. Use the OE Hardware to secure the Hangers. Torque to <u>10 ft-lbs</u>. *Figure 3*.





6. Locate the new Rubber Mounts. Install them onto the new Exhaust Hangers.

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7. Locate the Axle-Back and position it into the new rear hangers of the vehicle. *Figure 4*.






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8. Locate the Resonated Mid-Pipe, (1) one Exhaust Gasket, (2) two M10 Bolts and (2) two M10 Nuts. Place the Mid-Pipe in the OE Exhaust Hanger and join the flanged end to the Axle-Back with an Exhaust Gasket in between them. Loosely secure them together with an M10 Bolt and Nut on each side of the flange. *Figure 5*.





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9. Locate the Mid-Pipe, (2) two Exhaust Gaskets, (4) four M10 Bolts and (4) four M10 Nuts. Join the Mid-Pipe to the Y-Pipe and Resonated Mid-Pipe with an Exhaust Gasket in between each flange. Secure with the M10 Hardware *Figure 6*.




10. Locate the Tailpipes, Exhaust Tips and the (4) four Swivel Tip Clamps. Install an Exhaust Tip onto each Tailpipe and loosely secure with a Clamp. Insert each Tailpipe into the Axle-Back exits and loosely secure with a clamp. *Figure 7*.

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- 11. Tighten all Exhaust Hardware (except the Tailpipes) starting from the front of the vehicle at the Y-Pipe. Torque all Exhaust Hardware to <u>43 ft-lbs</u>.
- 12. Adjust the Tailpipes and Exhaust Tips to your desired fitment. Once positioned, tighten the (4) four Swivel Tip Clamps.
- 13. Wipe down the Exhaust to remove any grease, debris and fingerprints.
- 14. Start the vehicle. Check for any exhaust leaks and tighten hardware as necessary.
