Safety Requirements:

- Always wear safety glasses and any necessary protective garments. If using any fluids, chemicals, or solvents, a respirator is recommended.
- Always use properly rated jack stands when working under your vehicle.
- Always turn the ignition to the OFF position and disconnect the NEGATIVE battery terminal.
- Always keep limbs and parts away from moving drivetrain parts.
- Only operate drivetrain in safe space and well ventilated areas.

***BEFORE YOU BEGIN!**

Remove contents from the Z1 Motorsports 370Z / G37 Solid Differential Bushing Set and verify that ALL necessary hardware is present. Z1 Recommends freezing all Differential Bushings before installation. This will allow the material to contract and ease the installation process.

Procedure:

- 1. Assure the car's engine is turned off and place transmission in Park position (or in Reverse gear if equipped with a manual transmission). Apply Parking Brake.
- 2. Raise and support vehicle. Locate proper jacking points on vehicle's Chassis (Refer to vehicle's Owner's Manual).
- 3. Please refer to Nissan 370Z Factory Service Manual (FSM) for Differential assembly removal procedure. Subframe assembly without Differential is as shown:

4. Remove Factory Rear Differential Bushing.

<u>Note</u>: Rear Bushing is hydraulic-filled and will leak oil once broken.

- 5. Clean Bushing Area of Subframe. Remove sharp edges that may be present.
- 6. Locate Z1 Solid Rear Differential Bushing.
- 7. Install Solid Rear Differential Bushing. Place Bushing at front side of Subframe and orient such that tapered end is facing the rear of vehicle. Use of the Z1 Differential Bushing Install Tool is recommended for installation of Solid Differential Bushing. If you have purchased a Differential Bushing Installation tool, please refer to the instructions provided.



Note: Do <u>NOT</u> use a hammer to Tap Solid Bushing into position.

- 8. Using a 34mm Socket (or equivalent) and Hammer, tap factory Front Differential Bushings out of the differential.
- 9. Using a Rubber Mallet, tap Z1 Front Upper Bushing Differential Bushings into differential (as (Thick) shown). 10. Please refer to Nissan 370Z Factory Service Manual (FSM) for Differential assembly installation procedure. Differential 11. Carefully lower vehicle. 12. Perform a final test drive of the vehicle.
